

Fees payments and sums fixed and agreed by the Woodhall Spa Parish Council at a Meeting of the Council's Finance Committee held on 7th March 2017 to come into operation on 1st April 2017.

The fees payments and sums set out below apply where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is, or immediately before death was, an inhabitant or parishioner of the parish of Woodhall Spa, or in the case of a stillborn child, where the parents (or one of them) are or at the time of interment, were such inhabitants or parishioners who were on the current or previous year's electoral roll, or children of parents whose names appear on it. When a resident has moved away because of health reasons, i.e to move to a nursing home or to live with relatives, they will be charged the residents fee as long as their last known address was in the Parish of Woodhall Spa. In all other cases the non resident fees apply.

PART I – IMMEDIATE INTERMENT (For interment within 6 months of purchase)

vii. Cremated Remains plot 1.0m x 1.0m (maximum 2 caskets)	£180.00	£340.00

All the above fees include the cost of digging the grave.

PART II – RESERVATION FEE

i. Grave space reserved when alive	£180.00	£360.00

In addition a fee as above will be due at time of burial

The reservation is for 50 years from the date of purchase not burial, and may be passed down through the family. At the end of 50 years the plot reverts back to the Parish Council together with all rights concerning the grave. Reserved plots can be returned to the Parish Council at anytime, however there will be no refund of purchase fees after 5 years. The deed holder must obtain the permission of the Parish Council if he/she wishes to erect a memorial.

PART III - MONUMENTS FOR BURIAL PLOTS

i. To erect a Monument to mark a grave	£75.00 (for both residents and non-residents)
iii. To add an additional inscription	£5.00 (for both residents and non-residents)

Monuments will be inclusive of vase, if required. All other information regarding the type and size of memorials allowed in the cemetery can be found within the cemetery regulations.

PART IV - MEMORIAL FOR CREMATION

i. To erect a plaque in memorial building	£85.00 (for both resident and non-residents)
